# Euaharlee Police Department Earns State Recertification

In late 2025, the Euaharlee Police Department was formally recognized for achieving State Certification through the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police (GACP). The certification plaque was presented during a City Council meeting by a GACP representative, marking a significant accomplishment for the department and the community it serves.

According to the GACP, state certification acknowledges the implementation of policies and procedures that are both operationally effective and aligned with recognized best practices in law enforcement. With more than 500 law enforcement agencies across Georgia, only about 12 percent currently hold this distinction, placing the Euaharlee Police Department among a small group of agencies meeting these rigorous standards.

This achievement reflects the department's ongoing commitment to professionalism, accountability, and continuous improvement. City leadership extends sincere appreciation to the entire Euaharlee Police Department staff for their diligence and dedication throughout the certification process.



Special recognition is also extended to Lieutenant McNelis, the department's State Certification Manager, whose attention to detail and persistence were instrumental in successfully completing the recertification process.

The City of Euharlee thanks its elected officials, city staff, and residents for their continued support and congratulates the Euharlee Police Department on this noteworthy accomplishment.
